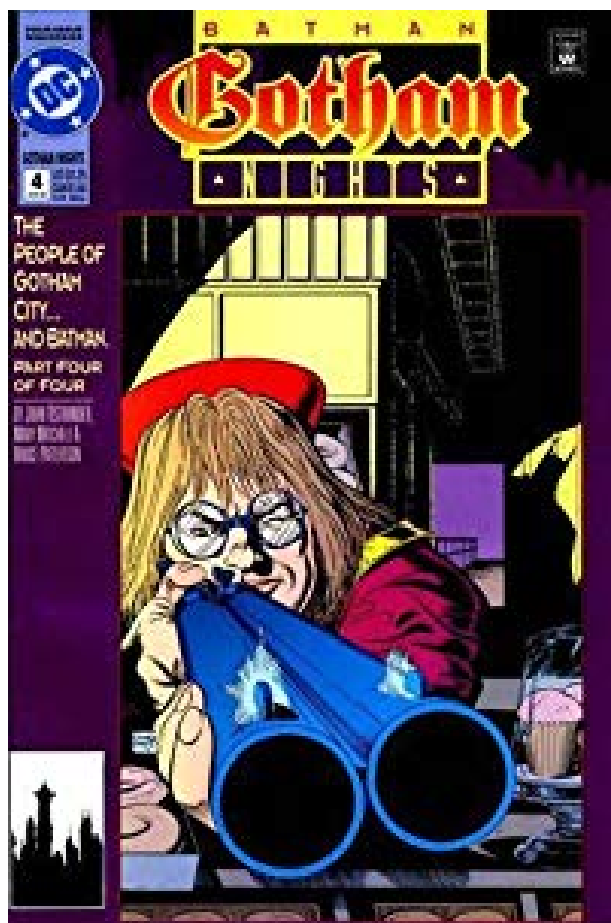

Dionisio Viella returns her fire, and the ricochets from his bullets cause various injuries, including a leg wound for Emma Mayfield.
